Books for the West Cork Book Fair.

1. American Big Game Fishing by Mrs. Oliver C. Grinnell and others including Ernest Hemingway. Published in 1935 in a special de luxe edition of only 56 copies (40 for sale) There is a full page, original drawing in pencil of a fish and birds by the illustrator, Lynn B. Hunt. Full maroon leather, gilt decorated. Minor wear, slight foxing to end papers but o/w close to fine internally.
2. Ben Hogan's 5 Lessons (in golf) 1st 1957 with a signed inscription from the author. "To Bill Curran with all good wishes and kindest personal regards, Ben Hogan." Some wear to slipcase and cover but VG+ internally.
3. The Playboy of the Western World by John M. Synge. Imprint Society, MA 1970 Edited by Stanley Sultan, with brush drawings by Louis Le Brocquy. Only 1950 issued. Signed by both editor and artist. Designed by Liam Miller and printed by the Dolmen Press. Bound by John F. Newman. Book and slipcase are both fine.
4. The Flying Column-West Kilkenny 1916-1921 by Jim Maher and signed by him. 1st edition 1987. Fine in fine d/w
5. The Schull and Skibbereen Railway by James I. C. Boyd. 1st 1999. Mint in mint d/w.
6. Rogha Dánta by Máirtín O'Direáin. 1st edition of only 1,200 signed copies 1949. Small h/b with glassine d/w. Three library stamps but o/w VG+ Rare in any condition.
